Sir,

With reference to your application dated 15-11-2007 on the above-cited subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for regular upgradation of your school from Middle to Senior Secondary level with Commerce & Humanities Streams w.e.f. Academic session 2008-09 (Without aid), to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions: -

- 1\* That the school will submit NOC from fire department of Delhi within three months from issue of letter of upgradation.
- 2\* That the school will not transfer any fund to society as creation of infrastructure is responsibility of society i.e. the school should abide by order dated 04/05/1997 and 15/11/1999.
- 3 That the school will charge the fee as per provisions of the Act and the Directions of the Deptt.
- 4 That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of DSEA & Rule 1973 framed there under as well as the instructions issued from time to time by the department.
- 5 That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
- 6 That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for the students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 Books per students shall be purchased and made available to the students.
- 7 That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available for the students.
- 8 That the employees of the school will be given pay and allowance & other prescribed benefits as provided under section 10(1) of DSEA & Rule 1973, and rule 125 of DSEAR & Rule 1973.
- 9 That the school shall not run any unrecognized classes or conduct any other activities within the school premises as per rule 50 of DSEA & R. 1973 and all the recognized classes shall be run at one place.
- 10 That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any immediately.
- 11 That the Managing Committee shall regulate the functioning of school strictly in accordance with the provisions of DSEA & Rule 1973.
- 12\* The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase fees in future academic session without prior approval of Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section of section 17 of DSEA & Rule 1973.

13. That the school shall submit the return to the Act branch of the Directorate of Education as per rule 180 (1) of the DSEA & Rule 19/3 annually.
14. That all the facilities prescribed under 60 & 61 of the DSEA & Rule 19/3 shall be made available to the students.
15. Proof of the effect that qualified staff shall be appointed as per rule 19/3 provided for verification by the E.O.
16. That the staff shall be paid all arrears and shall be paid as per 2<sup>nd</sup> part of the DSEA. Proof shall be given to E.O. for verification.
17. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately.
18. The school shall have the medium of instruction as per Rules 6, 7 and 8 of the DSEA & Rule 19/3.
19. Provident Fund register shall be maintained and cashbook shall be completed and shown to E.O. of the Zone concerned for verification from time to time.
20. That the violation of any instruction/ condition/ rules and regulations of the department shall lead to action against the school as per section 24 of the DSEA 1973.
21. That the school shall equip the Science lab as per norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
22. That the management of the school creates a Reserve fund as per norms.
23. All the conditions of recognition under section 4 of the Act will continue to be complied with.
24. The school authority would admit the students in such manner that each and every child gets at least 10 Sq. Ft area.
25. That the school grant minimum 15% free ship (which include T.F., P.T.A. or any other fees/ funds/ charges of any kind related to teaching - learning) to the children of the weaker section of the society w.e.f. Academic session -2008-2009.
